10.08.2026 (Monday)	I	Tri-Colour Collage Making (Intra Class Competition)	- Students will create a beautiful collage using the colours of the Indian National Flag, depicting themes of patriotism and unity. - Students are required to carry old magazines, newspapers, colours, sketch pens etc.
10.08.2026 (Monday)	II	Our State, Our Pride (Intra Class Competition)	Theme: Independence Students will express their love for the assigned state through creative drawings.
10.08.2026 (Monday)	III	Patriotic Singing (Intra Class Competition)	- Students will present patriotic songs that celebrate the spirit of freedom, unity and national pride. - Students are required to wear appropriate costumes according to the theme.
