A Glimpse of the Event

The Art & Craft Club of MBS International School organized a Poster Making Competition titled "**Jarurat Bani Musibat** - Plastic" for Class VIII on 29 July 2026. The activity aimed to sensitize students about plastic pollution and inspire them to take responsible action.

The session began with a brief discussion on how plastic, once a convenience, has now become a major environmental threat. Students of all 5 sections of Class VIII participated with great enthusiasm. They were given 1 and a half hours to design their posters.

Students used chart paper, colours, and slogans to depict issues like ocean pollution, choked drains, harm to animals, and health hazards. Creative slogans like _"Plastic Tyago, Dharti Bachao"_ and _"Refuse Plastic, Save Life"_ were seen on the posters.

The competition showcased excellent creativity, originality, and a strong social message. The activity successfully helped students understand that small steps like avoiding single-use plastic can bring big change.
