

CBSE Sankalp Sahodaya Training Programme on the mandatory implementation of Kaushal Bodh and Kaushal Vikas

ITL Public School successfully hosted a two-day CBSE Sankalp Sahodaya Training Programme on the mandatory implementation of Kaushal Bodh and Kaushal Vikas under the aegis of the Department of Skill Education, CBSE., on 16th and 17th July, 2026. The programme was graced by Smt. Bimla Gulia, Deputy Director of Education, who underscored the importance of integrating vocational awareness and skill-based education into mainstream schooling. In alignment with the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020, she highlighted how this transformative approach nurtures creativity, practical competencies, and future-ready learners. The workshop brought together over fifty Principals and Vice Principals from schools across the Delhi-NCR region to deliberate on the future of vocational education. The sessions were facilitated by Dr. Sudha Acharya, Principal, ITL Public School, and Dr. Jaishree Nawani, Principal, N.K. Bagrodia Global School, Dwarka. Participants explored the three core domains of work—Work with Life Forms, Work with Machines and Materials, and Work in Human Services—while understanding the continuum from exposure and exploration to specialisation and career readiness.

The facilitators also highlighted the distinction between Kaushal Bodh and Kaushal Vikas, while emphasizing essential transferable skills such as communication, collaboration, critical thinking, creativity, employability, entrepreneurship, digital literacy, ethical decision-making, and resource management. Designed as a highly interactive and experiential programme, the workshop engaged participants in collaborative research, competency-based lesson planning, interdisciplinary activity design, thematic presentations, and reflective discussions. Among its major highlights were the Agro-Climatic Zone and Crop Planning Challenge and the Sustainable Apparel Designing Challenge, in which school leaders upcycled discarded jeans into eco-friendly garments and bags. These activities demonstrated the power of multidisciplinary learning by seamlessly integrating concepts from Science, Mathematics, Social Science, Languages, Art Education, and Skill Education. The programme concluded with a valedictory session graced by Shri R.P. Singh, Associate Professor & Additional Director (Skill Education), CBSE. In his inspiring address, he encouraged school leaders to champion the effective implementation of Kaushal Bodh and Kaushal Vikas in their institutions, paving the way for a more holistic, competency-based, and future-oriented education system.
