Maximum Nominations	Each school may submit a maximum of 5 ideas. Of these, not more than 2 may be from students of Classes 11 or 12 (Science stream only).
Submission of the ideas to the Inspire In-charge	On or before 14 August 2026.

What Kind of Ideas Can Be Submitted?

Students are encouraged to submit innovative ideas based on science and technology, including:

- Concepts for new machines or gadgets that do not currently exist.
- Improvements to existing machines or devices to make them more efficient or multi-functional.
- Any innovation — machine, tool, or gadget — that solves a local technological problem.

Ideas will be evaluated on their **degree of novelty, social applicability, and potential impact**.

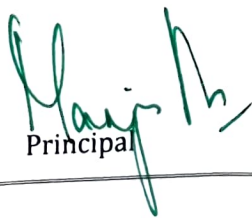
Students are advised to select their ideas, keeping these criteria in mind.

What Kind of Submissions Are Not Encouraged?

- Projects copied from textbooks or "Do-It-Yourself" websites will not be accepted.
- Simple demonstrations of basic concepts in Physics, Chemistry, Biology, or Mathematics are discouraged.
