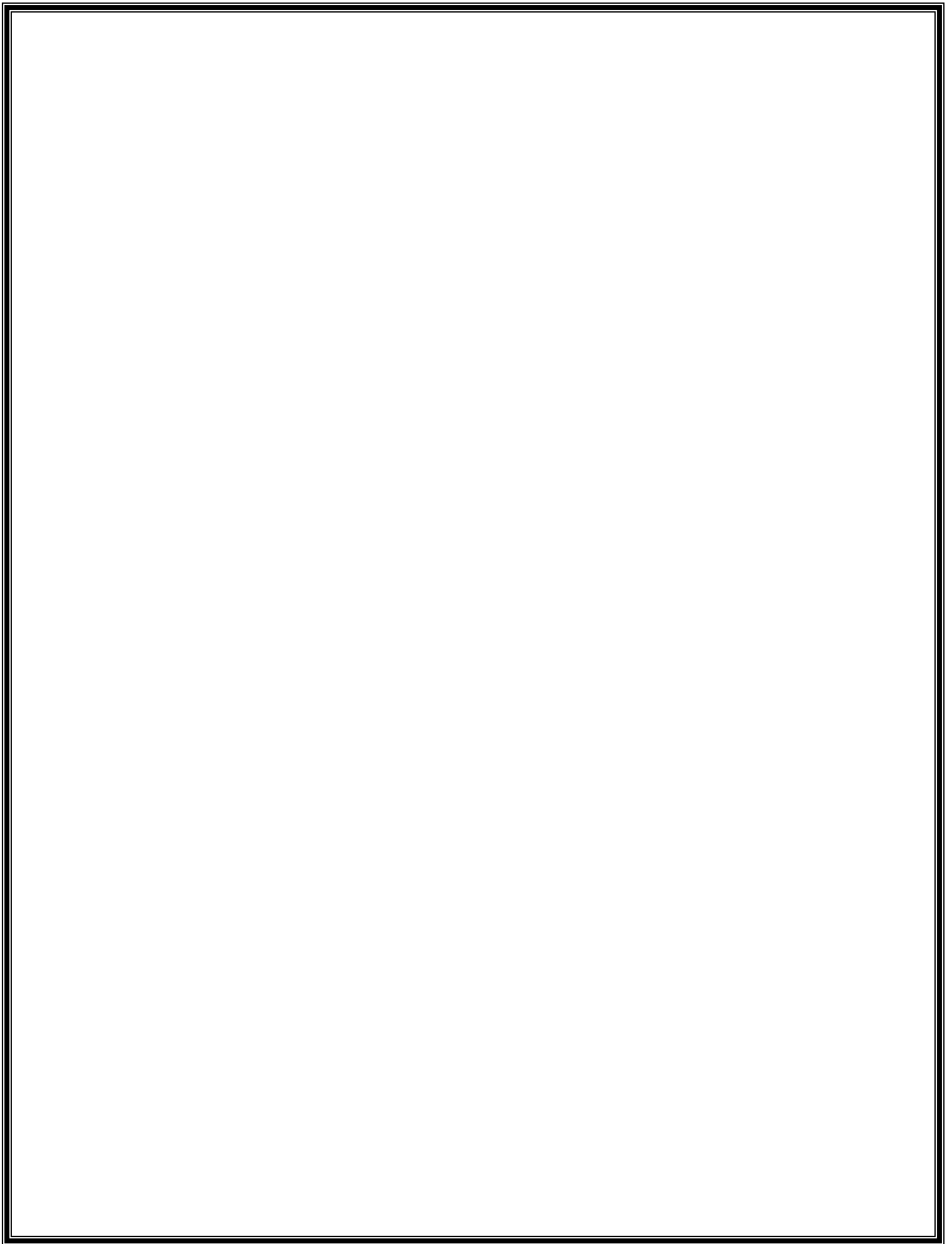

Lakshmibai, popularly known as the Rani of Jhansi, was the queen of the princely state of Jhansi. She was one of the great leaders of India's First Freedom Struggle of 1857.

She was born on 19 November 1828 in a Marathi family in Varanasi. Her parents named her Manikarnika. She was educated at home and trained in shooting, horsemanship and fencing. Manikarnika was married to the Maharaja or king of Jhansi, Raja Gangadhar Rao Newalkar, in May 1842. After her marriage to the Maharaja, she was called Lakshmibai.

After the death of the Maharaja in November 1853, the British East India Company decided to take her kingdom and asked her to leave the palace. But Rani Lakshmibai did not accept the decision of the British and fought against the British army very bravely. She fought with a sword while riding a horse. She inspired a lot of people to fight for India's freedom. She died in a battle in 1858, fighting for freedom.
