Q1) Assertion (A): $856 - 0 = 856$.

Reason (R): Subtracting zero from a number gives number itself as difference.

Q2) Assertion: $7 \times 9 = 9 \times 7$.

Reason: When the order of the numbers is changed, the product also changes.

Q3) Assertion: $0 \div 8 = 8$.

Reason: Zero divided by any non-zero number is zero.

Q4) **Assertion:** $450 - 450 = 0$.

Reason: Subtracting one from any number gives its predecessor.

Q5) **Assertion:** $48 \div 1 = 48$.

Reason: Dividing any number by 1 gives quotient as number itself.

Q6) **Assertion:** $6 \times 0 = 0$.

Reason: When a number is multiplied by zero, the product is the number itself.

Q7) **Assertion:** $542 \div 542 = 0$

Reason: Dividing a number by itself gives quotient 1.

Q8) **Assertion:** Double of 6 is 12.

Reason: Double of a number means adding the number to itself or multiplying the number by 2.
