"Empowering hands with skills; stitching sustainability into our future."

Under the Kaushal Vikas initiative, a specialized skill development workshop on Sustainable Denim Bag Making was successfully conducted on July 15, 2026.

The primary objective of this program was to provide vocational training in textile upcycling, turning domestic waste into livelihood opportunities. The workshop brought together local youth, self-help groups, and skill trainers to learn the art of transforming old, discarded denim jeans into high-quality, marketable tote bags, industrial pouches, and travel kits. Participants gained practical experience in heavy-duty fabric cutting, pattern making, structural stitching, and adding durable embellishments. Beyond technical skills, the curriculum emphasized the economics of eco-friendly entrepreneurship and the growing market demand for zero-waste products. The event concluded with an exhibition of the finished products, demonstrating the powerful impact of practical skill training in creating both self-reliance and environmental sustainability. Through this Kaushal Vikas program, participants left equipped with actionable vocational skills to start small-scale upcycling ventures.
