Dear Parent,

- The Mid-Term examination for Std XII is scheduled from 15/09/2026 to 30/09/2026.
- The **School timings during examination** days will be from **7:30 am to 11:30 am**. The school buses will depart from school at 11:30 am. Please be at your stops accordingly.
- Ensure your child carries all the required stationery for the examination.
- **Please note 12/09/2026 to 14/09/2026 will be preparatory leave.**
- **Non-examination days are preparatory leaves.** Students are not to report to school on non- examination days.
- The Midterm question papers have been set as per CBSE guidelines.
- **Mid-Term Examination Sample Question papers** will be available on the School website from **1st September 2026**. Solving the Sample papers will help students to get familiar with the exam pattern, question formats and time management.
- **No remedial classes will be conducted from 15/9/2026 to 30/09/2026.**
- **No re-exam will be conducted for students who are absent for the Mid-Term Examination.** However, if a student is unable to appear for an examination due to any of the following valid reasons:
 - (i) **Medical Grounds** – A formal leave application, along with valid medical documents/certificates, must be submitted to the school within three days of the student's rejoining.
 - (ii) **Participation in Inter-School Events** – This provision will apply only to students who are officially representing the school in an inter-school event.
- **Alternative Assessment:** A student who is unable to appear for an assessment due to a valid reason may be permitted to take the assessment on an alternative date scheduled by the school, subject to approval.
- Classes will resume after the Mid-Term examination on **05/10/2026**. Answer sheets of the Mid-Term examination will be shown to students on 05/10/2026. Attendance is compulsory on **05/10/2026**.
- The PTM for Mid-term Examination result will be held on **17/10/2026**.
