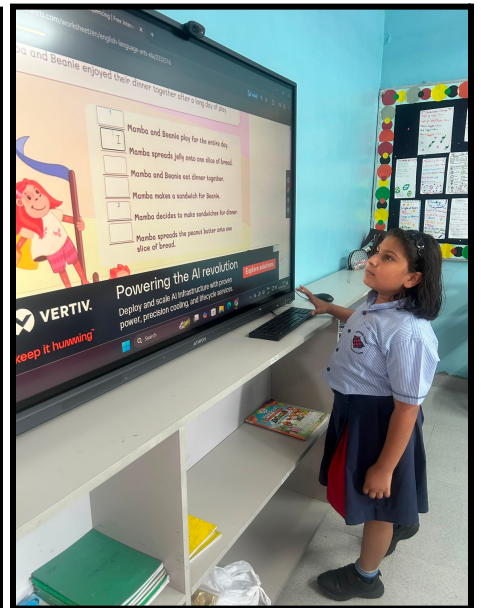
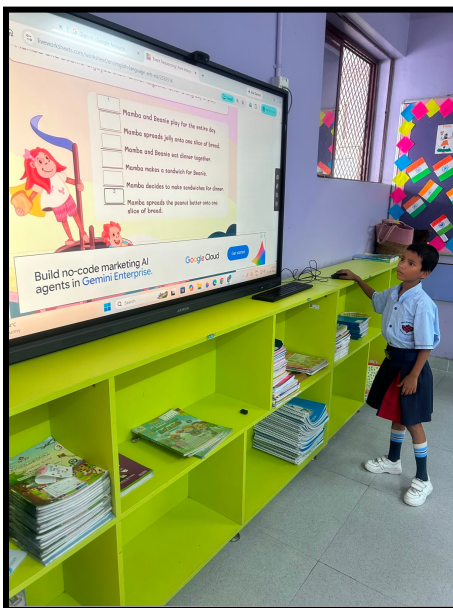

The activity strengthened students' **reading comprehension, logical thinking, sequencing skills, and storytelling abilities**, while making language learning interactive and enjoyable.

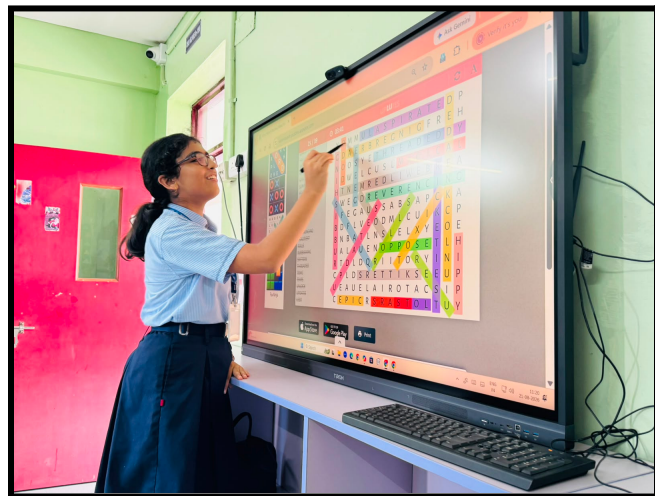
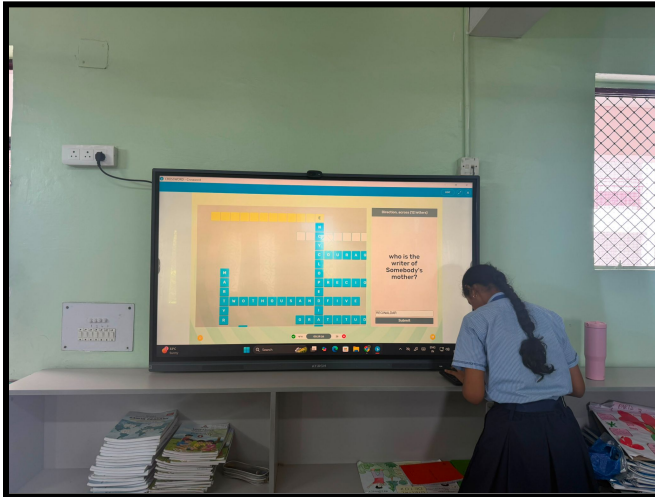


Classes 6-8
