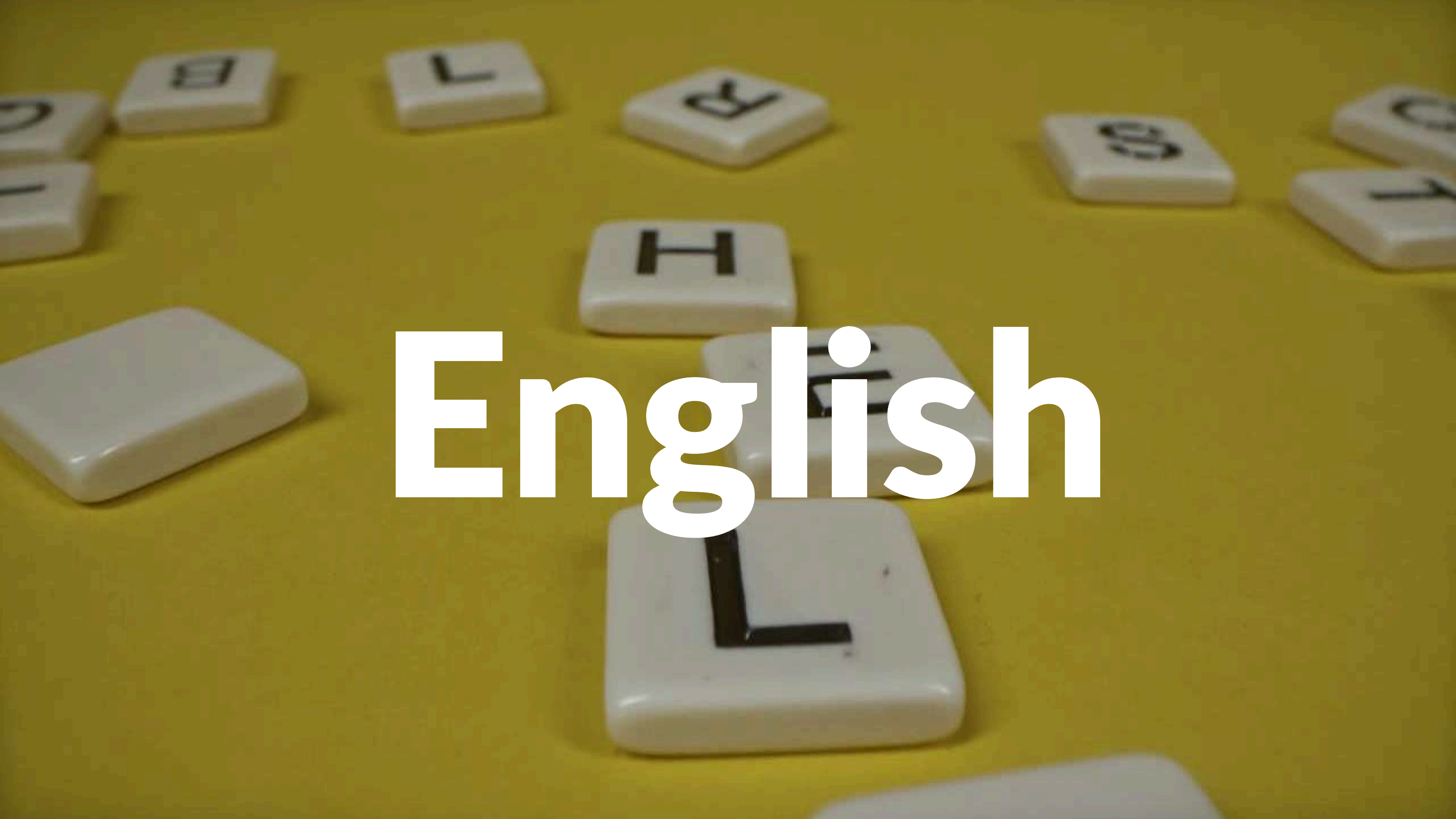

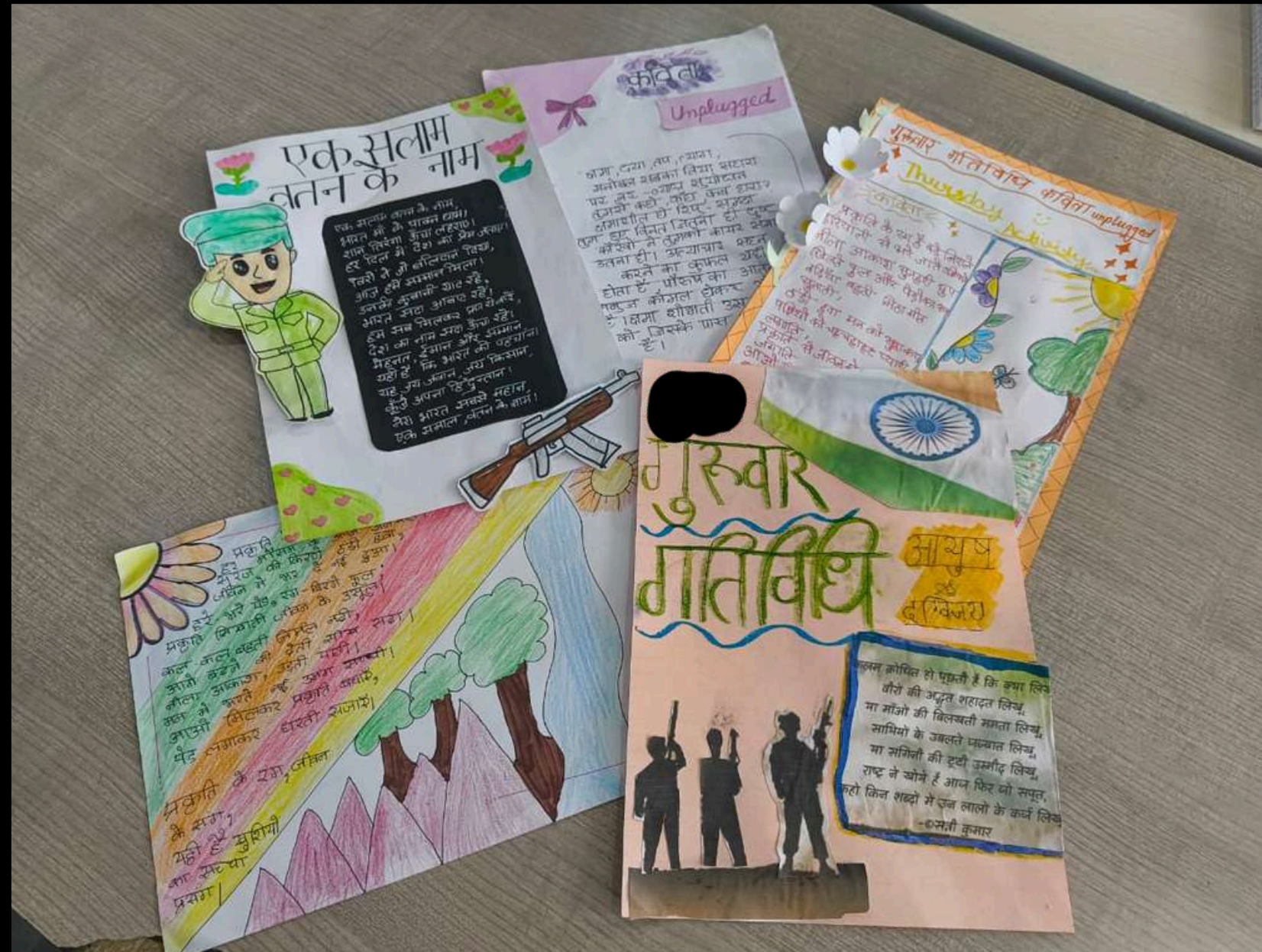
(कविता UNPLUGGED)

Every bubbling reaction sparked wonder, curiosity, and scientific conversations.

THE EXCITING INVESTIGATION REVEALED THAT ENZYME ACTIVITY WAS HIGHEST AT THE OPTIMUM TEMPERATURE, SLOWED DOWN IN COLD CONDITIONS ❄️, AND DECREASED AT HIGHER TEMPERATURES DUE TO ENZYME DENATURATION 🔥.

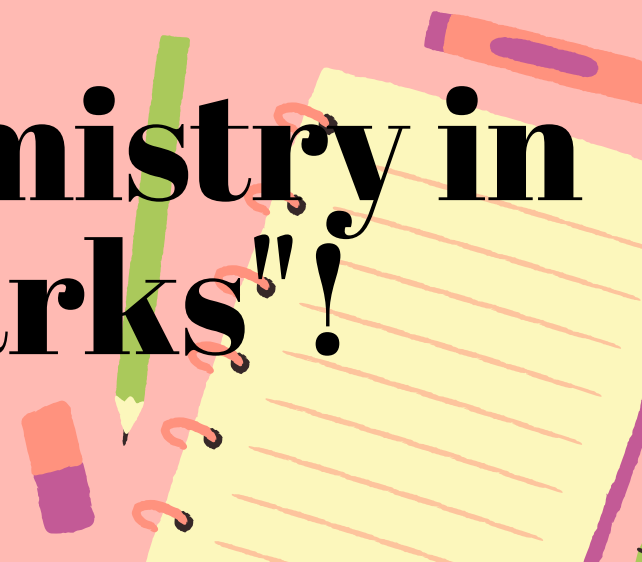


Chemistry

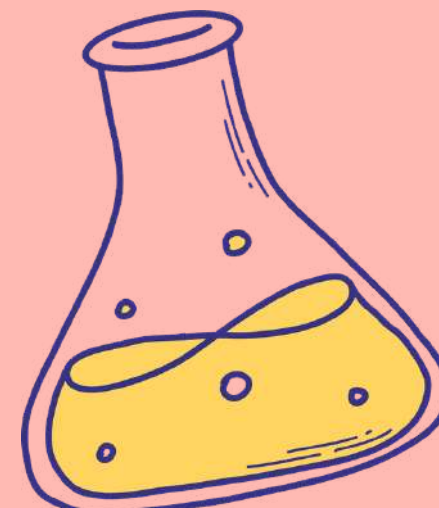


Class X students explored the magic of chemistry in our hands-on activity "From Salts to Sparks"!

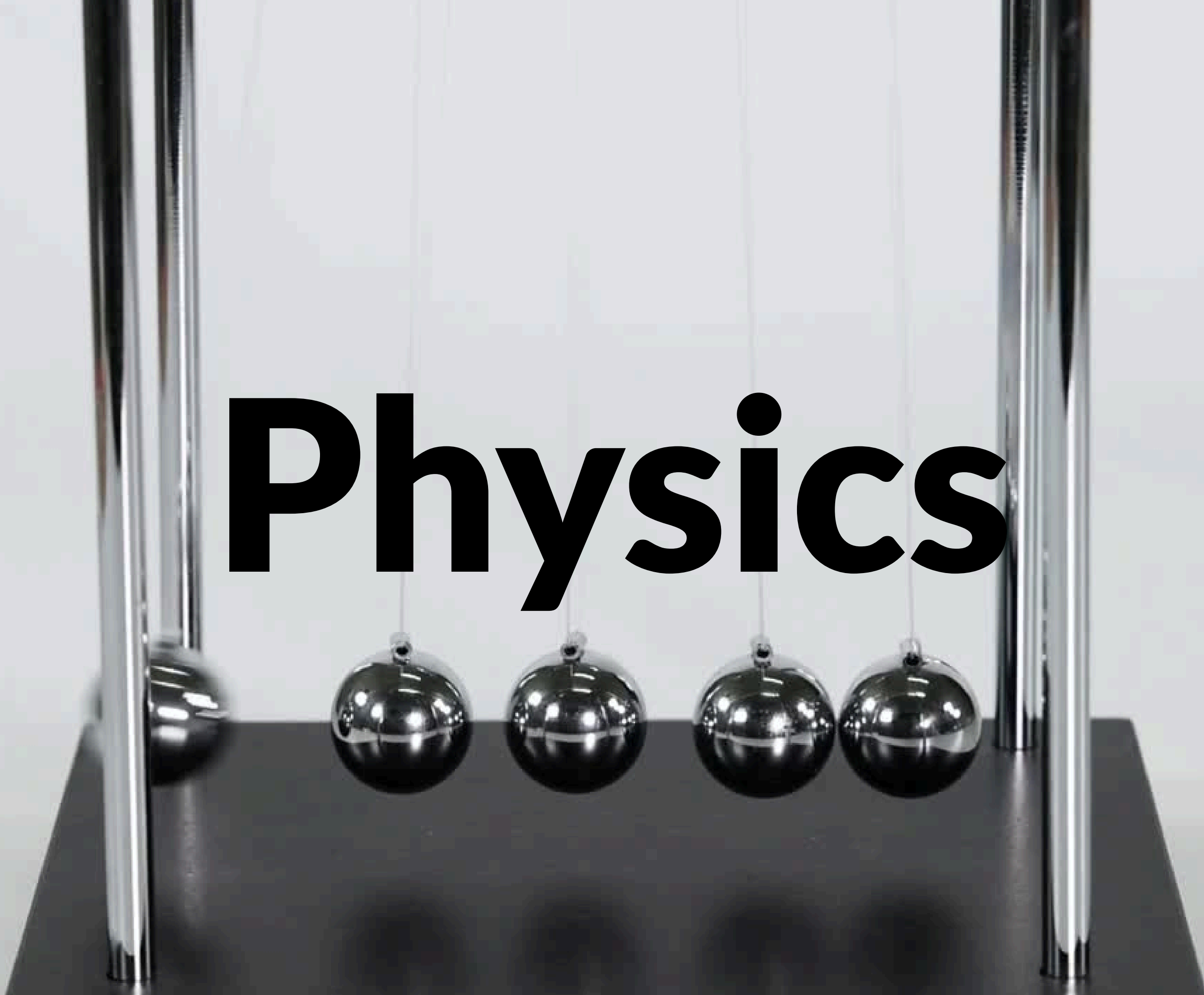


 **STUDENTS OBSERVED CHARACTERISTIC FLAME COLOURS OF DIFFERENT METAL SALTS.**

BMI CALCULATION

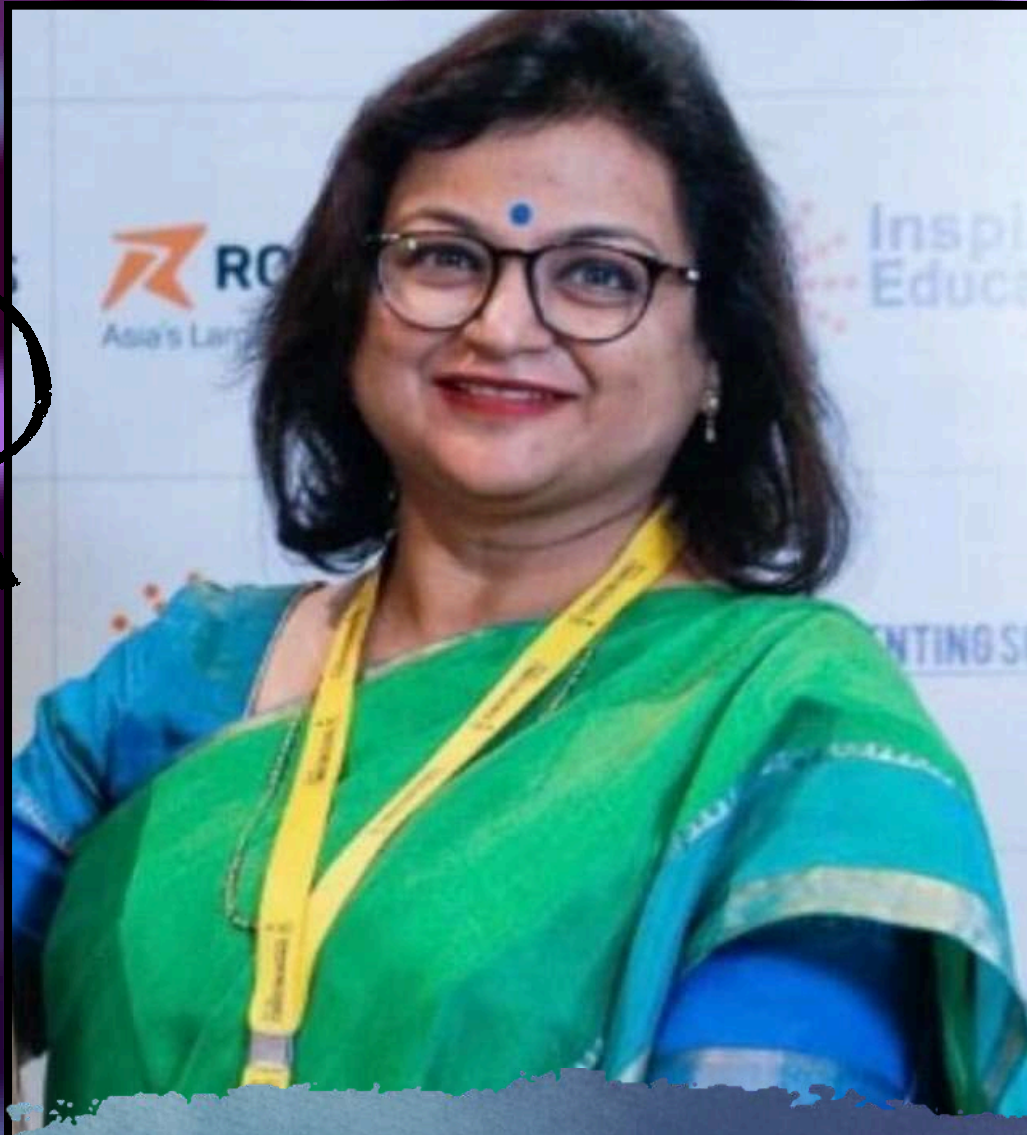


Students recorded their height and weight and calculated their BMI using the standard formula. The activity helped students understand the relationship between body weight and height.
