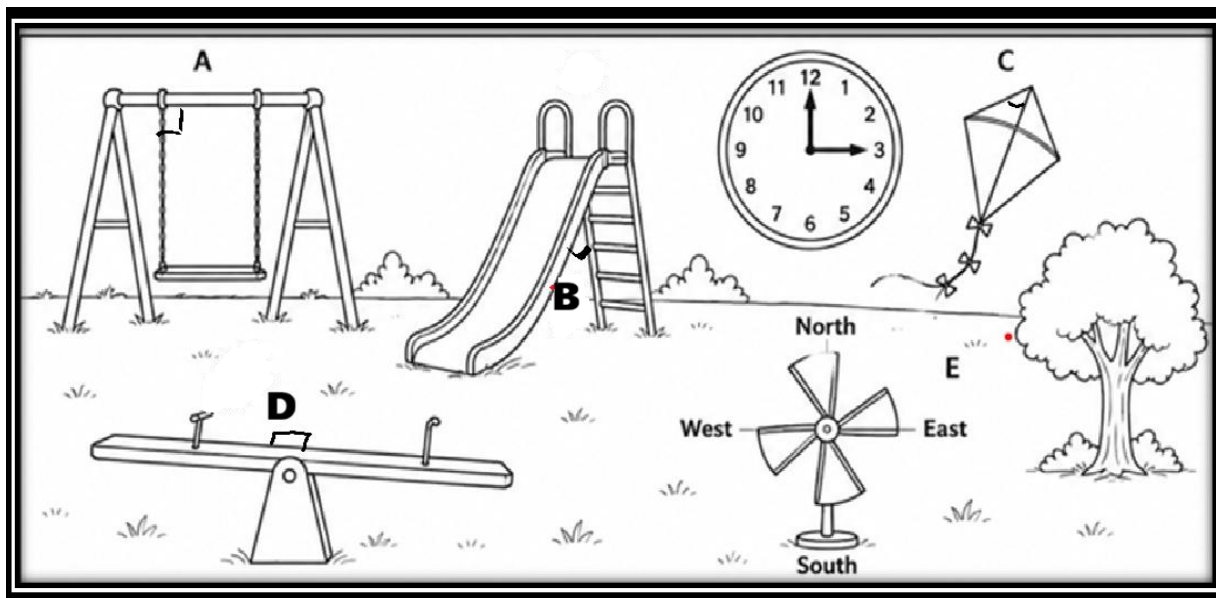

b) Identify the type of angle formed by the hands of the clock. - Right angle

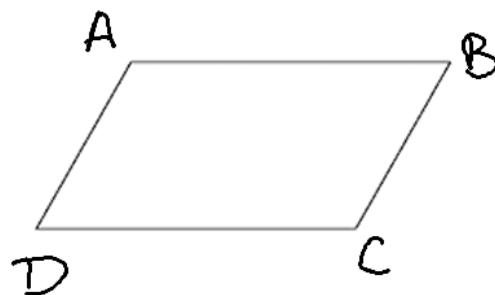
c) Which of the given objects shows an acute angle? Kite

e) If the fan (E) blade is pointing towards West and it makes a half turn clockwise, in which direction will it point now? East

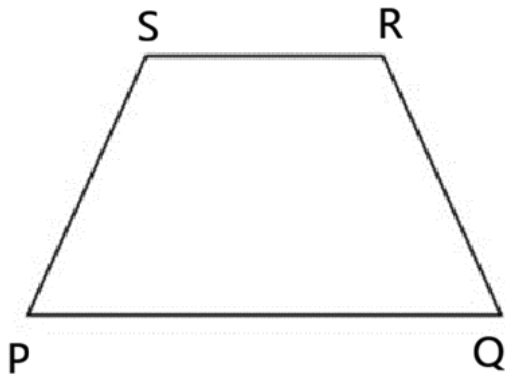

The bakery supplies these boxes daily to 4 supermarket branches equally. Answer the following: a) How many total cupcakes does the bakery produce in one day? Total cupcakes produced in one day = $35 \times 8 = 280$ cupcakes b) How many total cupcakes will the bakery produce in 5 days? Total cupcakes produced in 5 days = $280 \times 5 = 1,400$ cupcakes c) If 4 branches order 35 boxes each every day, how many total boxes do all 4 branches receive together in one day? Total no. of boxes received by all 4 branches in one day = $35 \times 4 = 140$ boxes	4

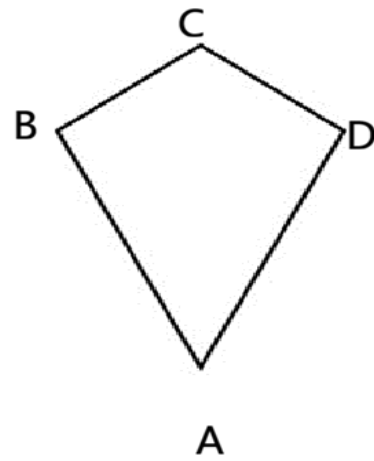
