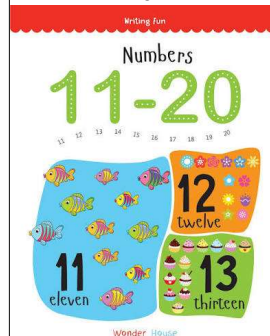

TRAFFIC LIGHT

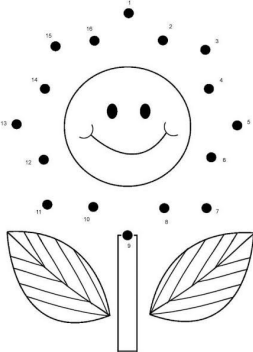
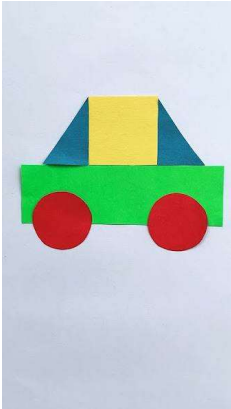
Teacher will draw outline of Traffic light on a chart paper. Students will tear and paste red, yellow and green coloured paper.

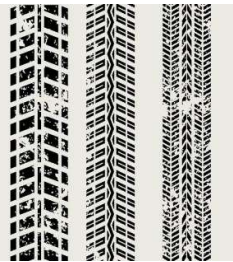


ASSEMBLY ON WORLD LITERACY DAY
