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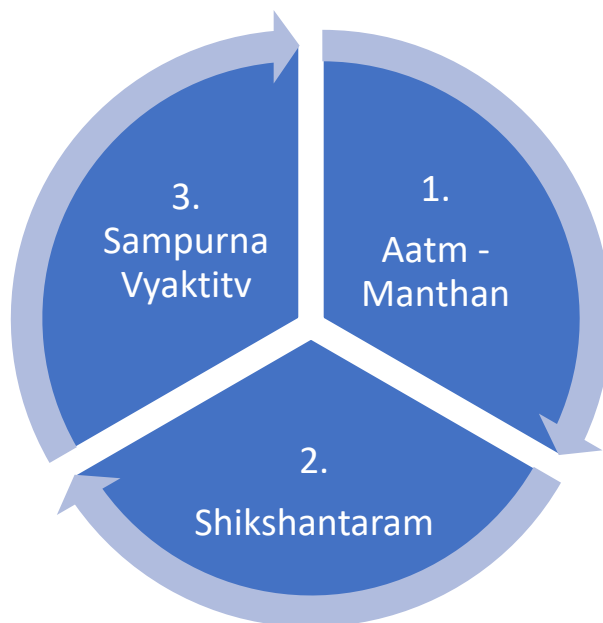

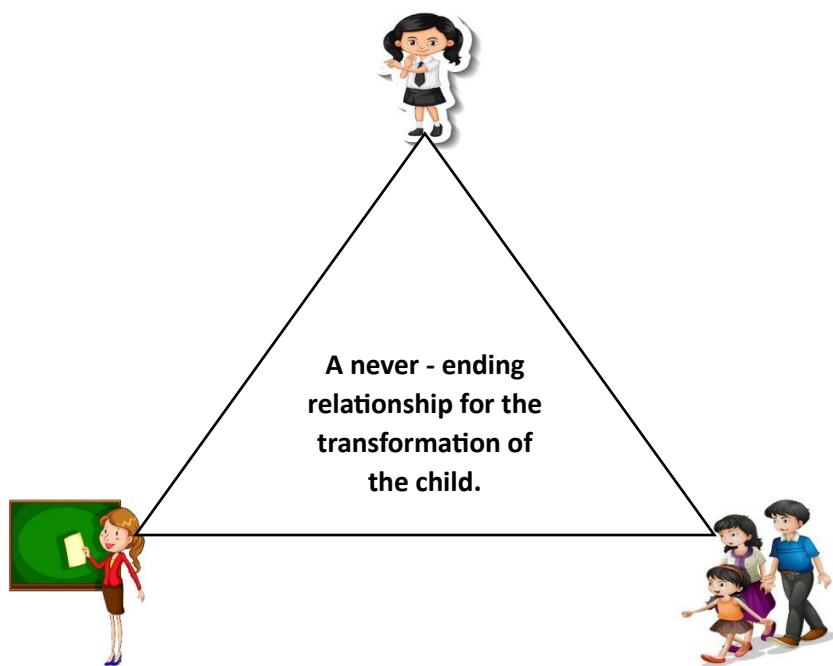

## **ROBOTICS AND ATAL TINKERING LAB**

In a quest to cater to the all-round development of the students and to keep pace with the upcoming advancements in technology and education, the school got associated with M/s. RoboSpecies Technologies Private Limited to set up a Robotics and Atal Tinkering Lab in school to train students about robot building and programming. A special lab solely dedicated for Robotics has been developed comprising of all the requisite and necessary equipments that would help children in the development of their logical and reasoning skills and train students about robotics, coding and STEAM.

## **EFFORTS MADE IN THE FIELD OF ENVIRONMENT**

### ➤ **SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT EDUCATION- PRINCIPAL'S SUMMIT**

The principal, Ms. Charu Srivastava was invited to be a speaker at the panel discussion hosted by Entab on November 24, 2023. The topic for discussion was sustainable development education- paving way to a greener future. Ms. Srivastava insisted that while taking action as a school, one must strive for a learner to showcase an overall change in personality where the learners are taking charge with the skills of inclusivity, collaboration, responsible, caring, perseverance, compassion towards each other and towards the planet as a whole. She spoke about the installation of the interact club at school to take initiatives towards making school a greener one.

- **ECO CLUB** at JM international school has been tirelessly working towards fostering environmental consciousness among students, staff, and the community. Through various initiatives and activities, we aim to create a sustainable future while instilling a sense of responsibility towards the environment.
- **TREE PLANTATION DRIVES:** The Eco Club organized several tree plantation drives within the school premises and nearby areas, contributing to the green cover and promoting biodiversity conservation.
- **WASTE MANAGEMENT CAMPAIGNS:** We conducted awareness campaigns on proper waste segregation, recycling, and composting techniques, encouraging students to adopt eco-friendly practices in their daily lives.
- **CLEANLINESS DRIVES:** Regular cleanliness drives were organized to maintain the cleanliness of the school campus and nearby areas, emphasizing the importance of a clean environment for overall well-being.

#### Outcomes:

- Increased awareness and participation among students and staff in environmental conservation efforts.
  - Significant improvement in waste management practices within the school premises.
  - Positive impact on the local community through outreach programs and collaborative initiatives.
- **DONATION OF OLD CLOTHES TO GOONJ NGO:** The club organized a heartwarming initiative where students from Grade I onwards donated their old clothes to Goonj NGO which recycles discarded clothes and household goods into useful products for the poor. This event was aimed at fostering a sense of social responsibility and empathy among the students, while also contributing to a noble cause. The event not only provided essential clothing to those in need but also instilled a sense of community service in the students.
  - **PLACING OF BIRD FEEDERS AND WATERERS:** Amidst rising temperatures, the club at our school took proactive steps to mitigate the effects of the scorching summer heat on local bird populations. The club organized a project to install bird feeders and bird fountains in various open spaces across the campus. The objective was twofold: to provide a source of nourishment and hydration for birds during the hot weather and to foster a deeper connection with nature among students.
  - **POSTER MAKING FOR A POLLUTION FREE ENVIRONMENT:** All mother teachers during the online classes spent at least 10 quality minutes discussing the root causes of pollution and the possible ways to prevent the same. The junior classes were made to understand what air quality index was all about. Post this discussion, all the learners created posters to spread the message of a pollution free environment.

## INNOVATIONS

**CBSE UNESCO Chuppi Todo Workshop by Ms. Anamika Chauhan, Special Educator and Counsellor held on November 02, 2023**

Preventing bullying and violence in schools is an ongoing process that requires the commitment of all stakeholders. It's essential to create a supportive and safe environment

where all students can learn and thrive without fear. Schools should also stay up-to-date with the latest research and best practices in the field of anti-bullying and violence prevention. JMIS learners under the guidance of their counsellor, Ms. Anamika watched a short film titled "Chuppi Todo" (Break the Silence) released by CBSE and UNESCO and deliberated on the matter on how to develop better interpersonal skills and respect everyone in the classroom.

### **Bhanu's Math Workshop**

**Mr. Neelkantha** Bhanu, President of India awardee and a revolution at Mental Mathematics is out on a social mission to **eradicate Math Phobia** from young minds and allow them to solve math problems at supersonic speeds! Students from grade IV to Grade VIII bagged a chance to attend this free of cost webinar along with their mentors and with their parents. The following were the learning outcomes of the webinar:

1. Students learn to solve complex math problems in seconds!
2. Consistent increase in math scores of schools that associate with us.
3. An opportunity for the students of your school to learn and connect with students from across the world.
4. Have a chance to be a part of a global Olympiad.

## **INNOVATIONS IN THE CLASSROOMS**

### ➤ **Worksheet Box**

In order to engage the fast learners and the fast finishers in the classroom, JMIS mentors have placed a worksheet box in the classroom. The worksheets are challenging brain teasers and mind bender games which enable the child to inculcate the habit of critical thinking, analysis and problem solving.

### ➤ **Word Wall**

In order to enhance the vocabulary and familiarise the children with new words from the chapters, the word walls are put up in the classrooms. These are concept related words which the learners can learn and use.

### ➤ **Thinking / What If questions**

Thinking questions are asked in the assembly every morning. The same question is put up in the classroom to enhance student thinking.

### ➤ **Student corner and Reflection Corner**

Each classroom has a student corner which allows the learners to express freely.

### ➤ **Doubt class**

After each lesson is over, a doubt class is a must. All the queries related to the lesson are addressed in the doubt class.

### ➤ **Smiley Chart**

Whenever the children do good with oneself, others or gives a creative response in the class, they get a smiley. The maximum smileys holder at the end of the month is rewarded an appreciation card.

### ➤ **Mission English Chart:**

JMIS encourages each learner to express themselves in the official language of the country that is English. Sparkies in the mission English chart are cut as soon as the learner speaks in Hindi in subject classes (barring Hindi and Sanskrit).

### **Onboarding for HW app by all teachers**

Homework is an important platform that helps the learners revise, reinforce and reconstruct their classroom learning. It is with great sense of responsibility and happiness that we announce our association with HW App, a platform where homework turns into HomeFun. The App will be an added advantage to regular homework assigned by the mentors.

HW App has been set up by Sh. Harshbardhan, an IITian who has a vision to serve the children of India. The App caters to more than 10,000 who love it. It consists of 9 lakhs+ pre typed objective and subjective questions across all subjects. The daily quiz for the topics can be created in less than 30 seconds. It also gives a detailed report on how children are doing individually and as a class.

The school understands that the parents invest a huge amount of effort and finances in giving the best to their children. As a partner in your child's education, the school has decided that the app and its benefits will bear NO COST for the parents and students.

HW App will be an additional support and tool of learning for the parents, students and mentors and will not be a replacement to regular HW.

### **Cambridge training- play based approach – November 10, 2023**

Mentors at JMIS empowered themselves through a workshop organised by Cambridge University Press on the topic, - Play based approach. The mentors learnt how to organise play based activities which can be free or guided in nature. Also, play based approach to learning is threat- free and more engaging for the children at all levels.

### **Collaboration with Educational Initiatives**

Educational Initiatives organised an online session for all the math and science mentors on the topic- Enhancing learning outcomes where mentors teaching Math and Science across all grades participated. The learners understood the 'why' of making questions, types of questions and how to bring clarity on misconceptions.

### **Collaboration with FairGaze**
