

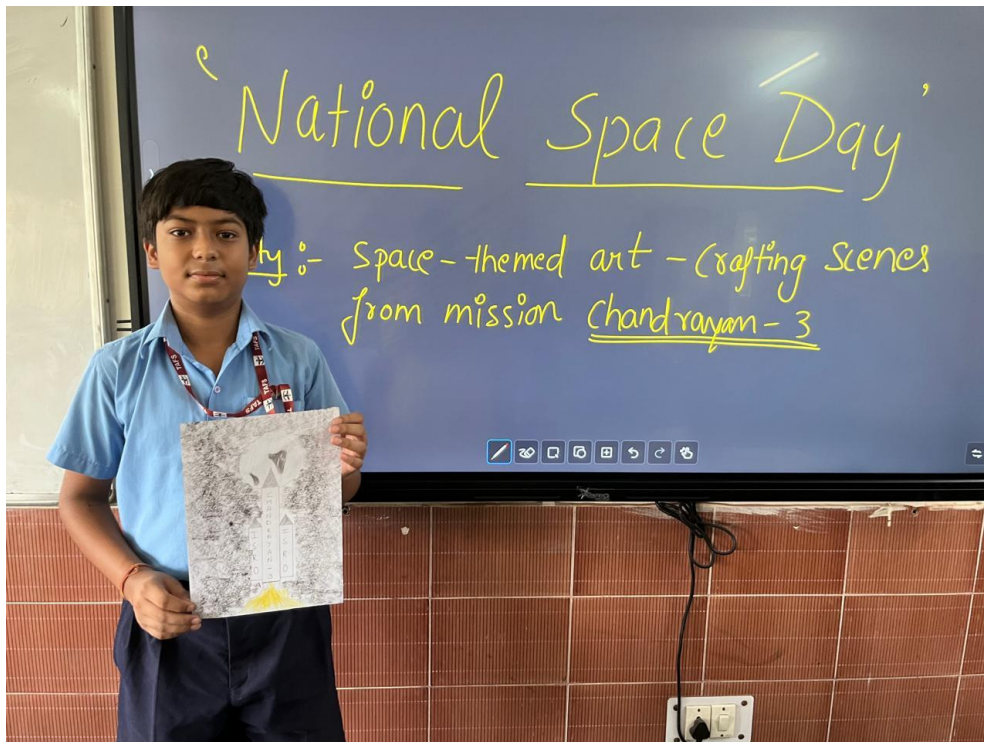
NATIONAL SPACE DAY

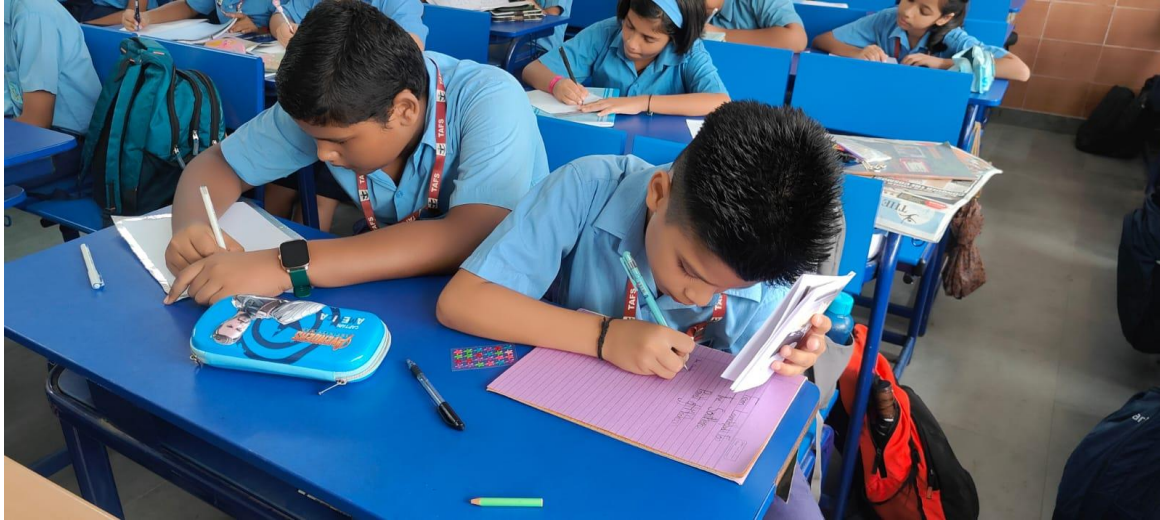


CLASS VII: PARAGRAPH WRITING: FROM LAUNCHPAD TO SOUTHERN POLE
