### **Partition Horror Remembrance Day**

**14 SEPTEMBER 2024**

On September 14, 2024, Air Force School Subroto Park, Delhi, commemorated Partition Horror Remembrance Day by hosting a play that aimed to evoke memories of the horrific events and massive human suffering experienced during the Partition of India in 1947. The students of class XI & XII performed the activity.

The play successfully conveyed the pain and suffering experienced by millions during the Partition. The strong performances of the students allowed the audience to connect with the characters' emotions, making the historical events feel personal and real.

The play included significant moments such as the All India Radio announcement broadcast about the peaceful transfer of power and the agreements made by historical figures like Lord Mountbatten, Jawaharlal Nehru, and Muhammad Ali Jinnah. This attention to detail added a layer of authenticity to the performance.
