


Educational-cum-Excursion Trip to Udaipur and Chittorgarh (15th November – 19th November 2024)

Classes Involved: Class 6 and 8



Introduction

Delhi Public School, Maruti Kunj, organized an exciting and educational trip to the historic cities of **Udaipur** and **Chittorgarh** from **15th to 19th November 2024**, specially curated for students of **Classes VI to VIII**. Itinerary

- After breakfast, the group traveled to the iconic **Chittorgarh Fort**, a UNESCO World Heritage Site located 175 kilometers from Udaipur.
- Students explored historical landmarks such as the Victory Tower, **Maharani Padmini Mahal**, and the **Meera Temple**, while also learning about the **historic site of Jauhar**, a symbol of Rajput bravery and honor.
