- ➤ Compose a winter-themed poem with at least three stanzas. Use describing words to describe the sights, sounds, and feelings of winter.


3. Grammar Fun

SCIENCE

Q1. Explore the behavior of light and image formation and make a report using the inner (concave) and outer (convex) surfaces of a spoon, and to verify the law of reflection using a mirror, flashlight, and protractor. For details follow the following instructions:

1. Materials Required:

- o A metal spoon (clean and reflective).
- Notebook for recording observations.

2. Procedure:

- O Hold the spoon's inner surface (concave) close to your face and observe your image. Gradually move the spoon farther away and note how the image changes in size and orientation.
- Now turn the spoon and observe its outer surface (convex). Move the spoon closer and farther from your face and note the changes in the image.

3. Observations:

- o Describe how the image appears on the **concave surface** (size, clarity, orientation).
- o Describe how the image appears on the **convex surface** (size, clarity, orientation).

4. Questions

- Why does the image on the concave surface appear inverted or magnified when the spoon is moved?
- Why does the image on the convex surface always appear smaller and upright?
