

## TRAFFIC AWARENESS CAMPAIGN REPORT

On August 5, 2024, a team of officers from the Gurgaon Traffic Police visited Delhi Public School Maruti Kunj to educate students from classes VI to XII on traffic safety. Following the traffic department's directives, the session aimed to raise awareness about road safety and responsible commuting. Principal Mr. Akhilesh Chandra Chaturvedi addressed the students, highlighting the significance of following traffic rules.



Traffic Inspector Mr. Devender Kumar from Gurgaon explained the importance of various traffic signs and informed students about the emergency helpline 112, which they can call for assistance. He assured them the police would track the caller's location and respond within seven minutes if required.



The session emphasized key traffic rules, including the prohibition of driving two-wheelers or four-wheelers without a valid government-issued driving license. Additionally, students were informed that private vans transporting children must not exceed their designated seating capacity.



The visit by the Traffic Department aimed to reinforce these regulations and promote student safety. Parents were encouraged to follow these guidelines and take necessary precautions to ensure a secure commute for their children to and from school.
