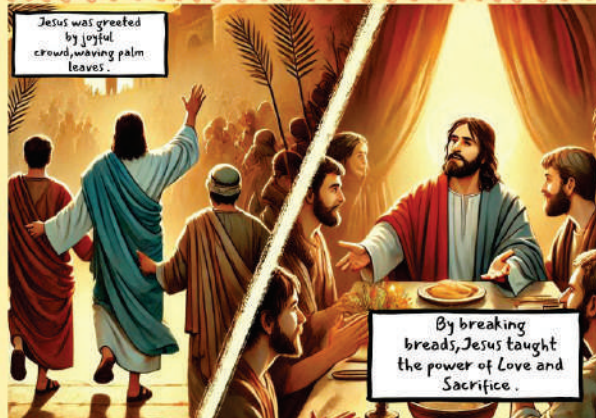

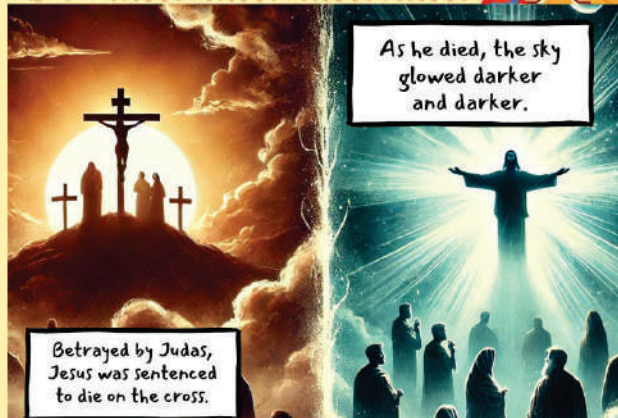
Easter is a joyful celebration of Jesus Christ's Resurrection, bringing hope and new beginnings. It reminds us of love, kindness and the beauty of renewal.

When witches go riding and black cats are seen, the moon laughs and whispers near Halloween. *-Ariane*

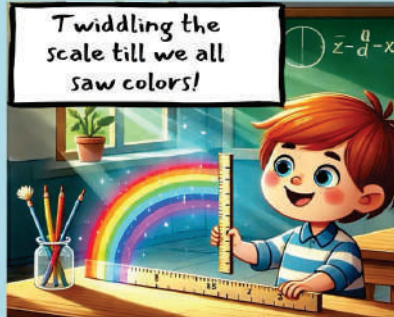
