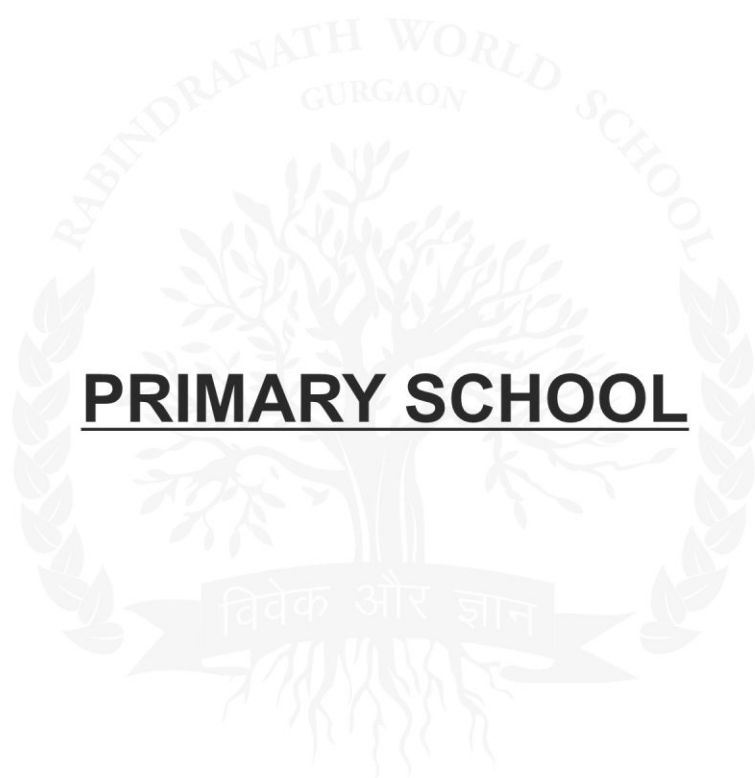

PROMOTION POLICY / RULES

1. The academic year is divided into two terms and two examinations are held in each term.
2. In order to be declared as 'Passed', a student should obtain atleast 40% marks in each of the five subjects separately and in aggregate.
3. A student has to secure 40% marks in Internal Assessment as well.
4. A student having less than 75% attendance in an academic session shall not be permitted to appear in the Final Examination.
5. Students will be awarded marks as well as grades.
6. It is mandatory to appear in all examinations.
7. There is no provision of a retest.

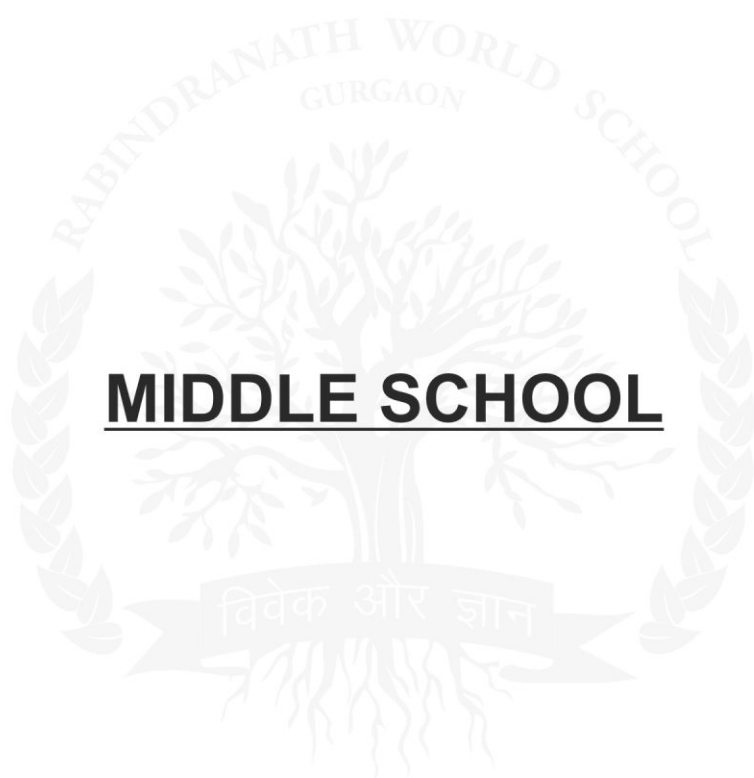
CLASSES I - V	LEARNING OUTCOME

EXAMINATIONS

Class VI to VIII – Periodic Tests are conducted as per the Examination Schedule given in the year book and a Half-Yearly examination in September/October, based on the course covered. Final examinations are held in February/March. Regularity in attendance during all tests is imperative. There is no provision of a retest.

SCHEME OF EXAMINATIONS AND ASSESSMENTS

1. The academic year is divided into two terms and examinations are held at the end of each term.
2. Evaluation of the Scholastic Aspect will be conducted according to the CBSE guidelines which are tabulated below.
3. Attendance for all tests is compulsory.
4. Students found using unfair means during any Periodic Test or Term Examination will be marked zero in that subject. These students will not be eligible for any academic award or school appointment.
5. The final result will be calculated by taking 50% weightage of the Periodic Tests + 100% weightage of Note Book, 33% weightage of Multiple Assessments + 75% weightage of Half Yearly and Final Exam.
6. We hope that with the cooperation and support of the parents, we shall be able to make a success of this system which is a path breaking initiative taken by CBSE for holistic development of the students in a conducive environment.

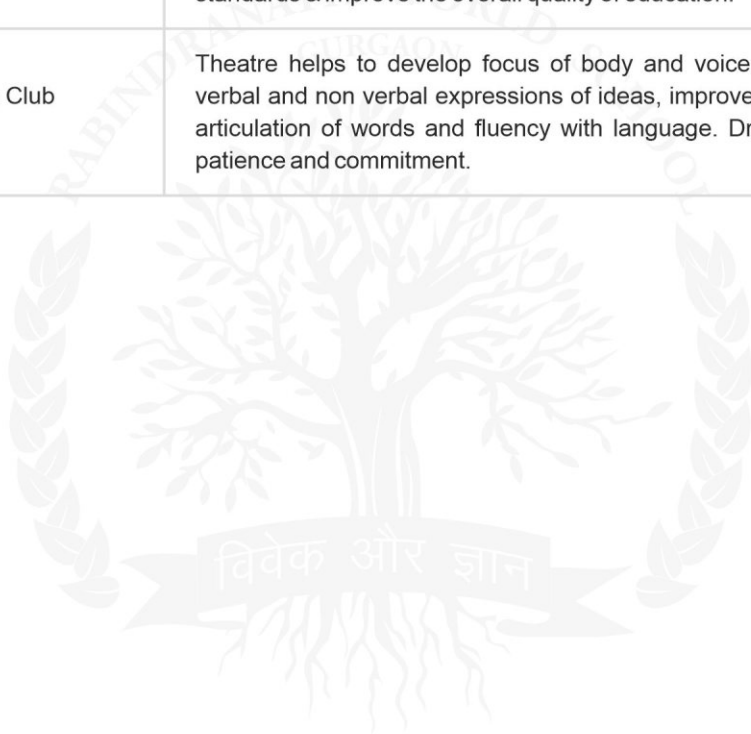
