  - Assisting grandparents or younger siblings



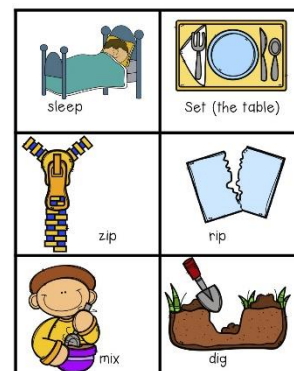

- Example: “My puppy runs, jumps, and digs for bones.

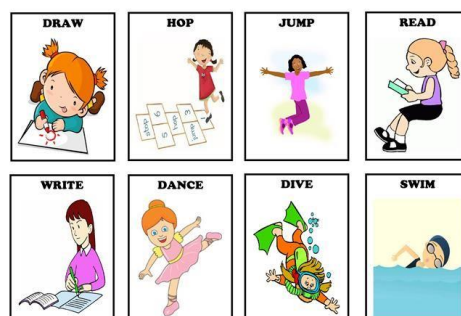

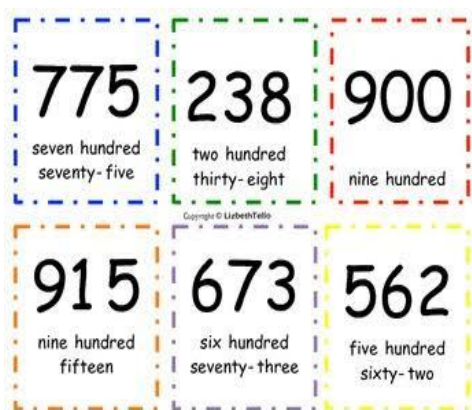
By using flashcards from a 4-digit number and write its number name, place value. Click on the reference link-

Research: What type of nest does it make? What materials does it use?

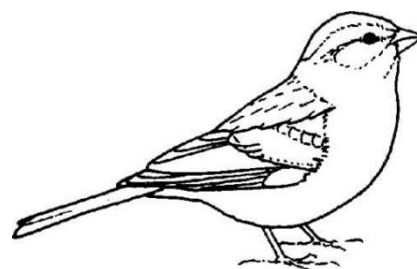
Create: A model of its nest using natural or craft materials.

**Task:**

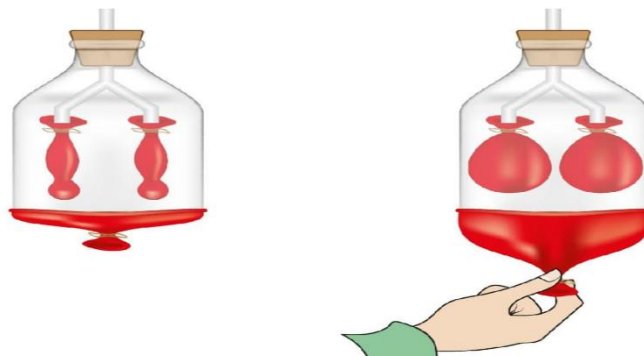
Make a working model of lungs using:
