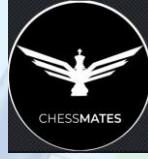

GENERAL GUIDELINES

- Schools must confirm their participation by submitting the duly filled **Online Registration Form** latest by **Saturday, 04 October, 2025**.
- **On the day of the event, registration at DPS Dwarka** will be from **08:00 a.m. to 08:45 a.m.**
- Events for classes **Pre-School to V** will be conducted under the title **Mélange 2025** while events for **classes VI to XII** will be held under the title **Spectrum 2025**.
- Only one entry per school per event will be accepted.
- Schools must ensure that no student participates in more than one event.
- All students must be in their school uniform, unless otherwise specified for a particular event. The school monogram on the uniform must be concealed with white paper.
- All participants must carry their School Identity Cards.
- All participants are requested to bring their own snacks/ lunch and water bottle.
- Schools are requested to send two teacher escorts with the participants to ensure proper coordination and discipline.
- The host school will retain all entries submitted for judgement.
- **The decision of the judges will be final and binding.**

EVENT	:	SQUARE 64 - CHESS TOURNAMENT
MODE OF CONDUCT	:	On-site
ELIGIBILITY	:	Classes VI-XII
NUMBER OF PARTICIPANTS	:	A team of 2 students per school

GENERAL GUIDELINES

All matches will follow FIDE rules.

- Each team comprises two players.
- The matches will be played with 10 + 0 time control.
- The tournament will consist of 4 rounds.
- Players must carry valid ID-cards, signed by the school Principal.
- Pairing will be based on ranking.
- Teams must report 30 minutes prior to their scheduled match.
- Walkover time is 10 minutes.
- Decision of the tournament committee will be final and binding on all teams.
- Electronic devices/wrist watches /mobile phones will not be permitted in the playing arena.
- In case of a tie, the latest FIDE tiebreak rules shall apply.

EVENT	:	MATELINE - THE CHESS QUIZ
MODE OF CONDUCT	:	On-site
ELIGIBILITY	:	Classes IX-XII
NUMBER OF PARTICIPANTS	:	A team of 2 Students per School

GENERAL GUIDELINES

- Each team will consist of two players.
- The Quiz will be conducted in 3 rounds:
- **Round 1**
 - All registered teams will participate in this written round of 20 questions flashed onscreen.
 - Half of the teams will qualify for the next round.
- **Round 2**
 - Onstage Written Round
 - Top 6 teams will qualify for this round.
- **Final Round** - Bid to Buy Questions Round.
- **Marking Scheme :**
 - Questions will be auctioned.
 - Each question will have a starting bid.
 - Teams must bid to win the chance to answer (min. raise of 5 points)
 - Each correct answer earns the stated points.

➤ Example: A question starts at 5 points. Reward is 25 points. Each team will get 2 attempts. If they answer correctly, they earn 25 reward points, regardless of their bid.

JUDGEMENT CRITERION

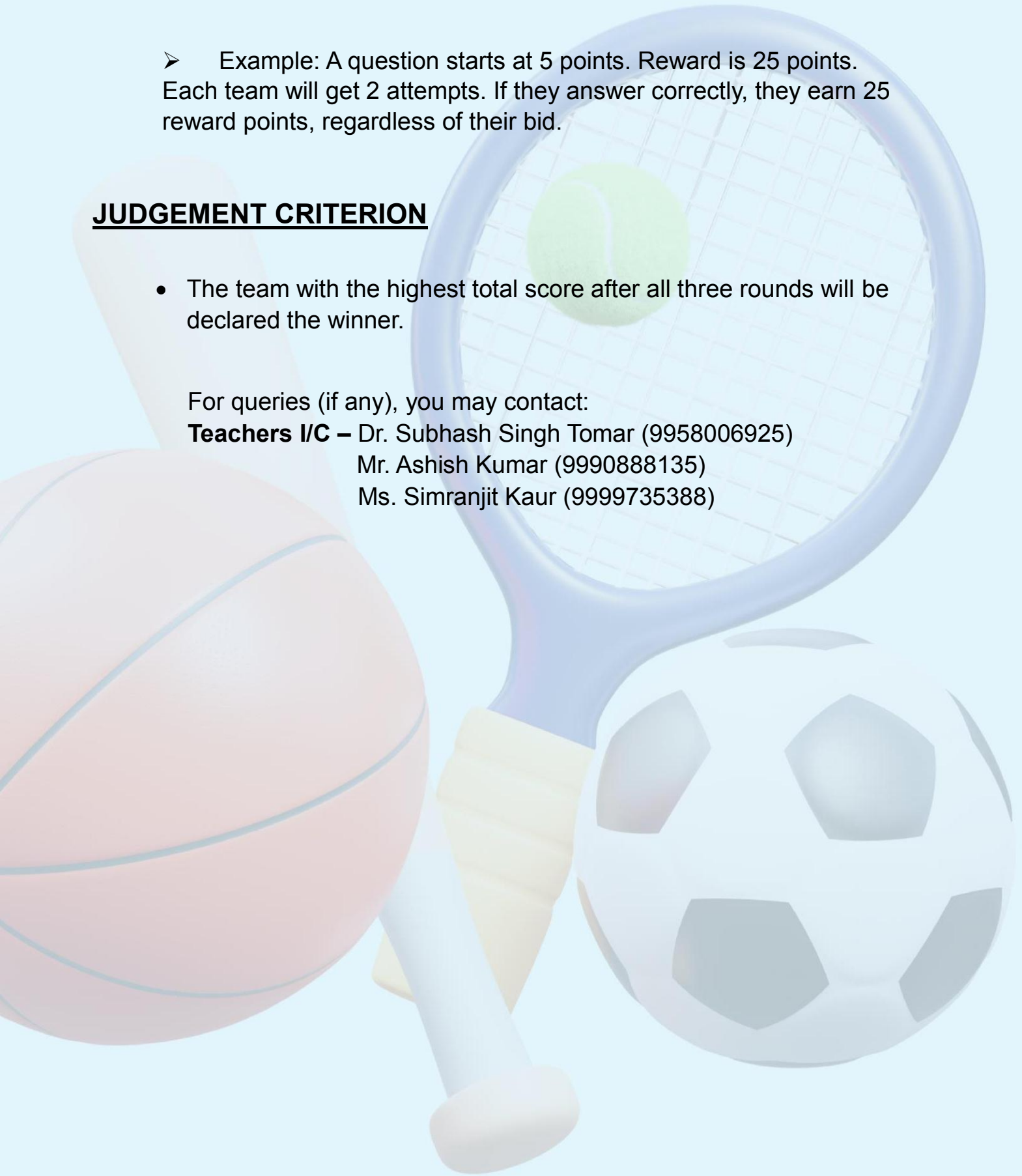
- The team with the highest total score after all three rounds will be declared the winner.

MODE OF CONDUCT	: On-site
ELIGIBILITY	: Classes IX-XII
NUMBER OF PARTICIPANTS	: 1 student per School

GENERAL GUIDELINES

- Each school team comprises one player.
- **Debate format :**
 - **Opening Argument:** 60 seconds per team
 - **Cross questioning:** 45 seconds per team
 - **Closing Statement:** 45 seconds per team
- Only one round will be conducted.
- Topics will be given on the spot. 30 minutes will be provided for preparation.

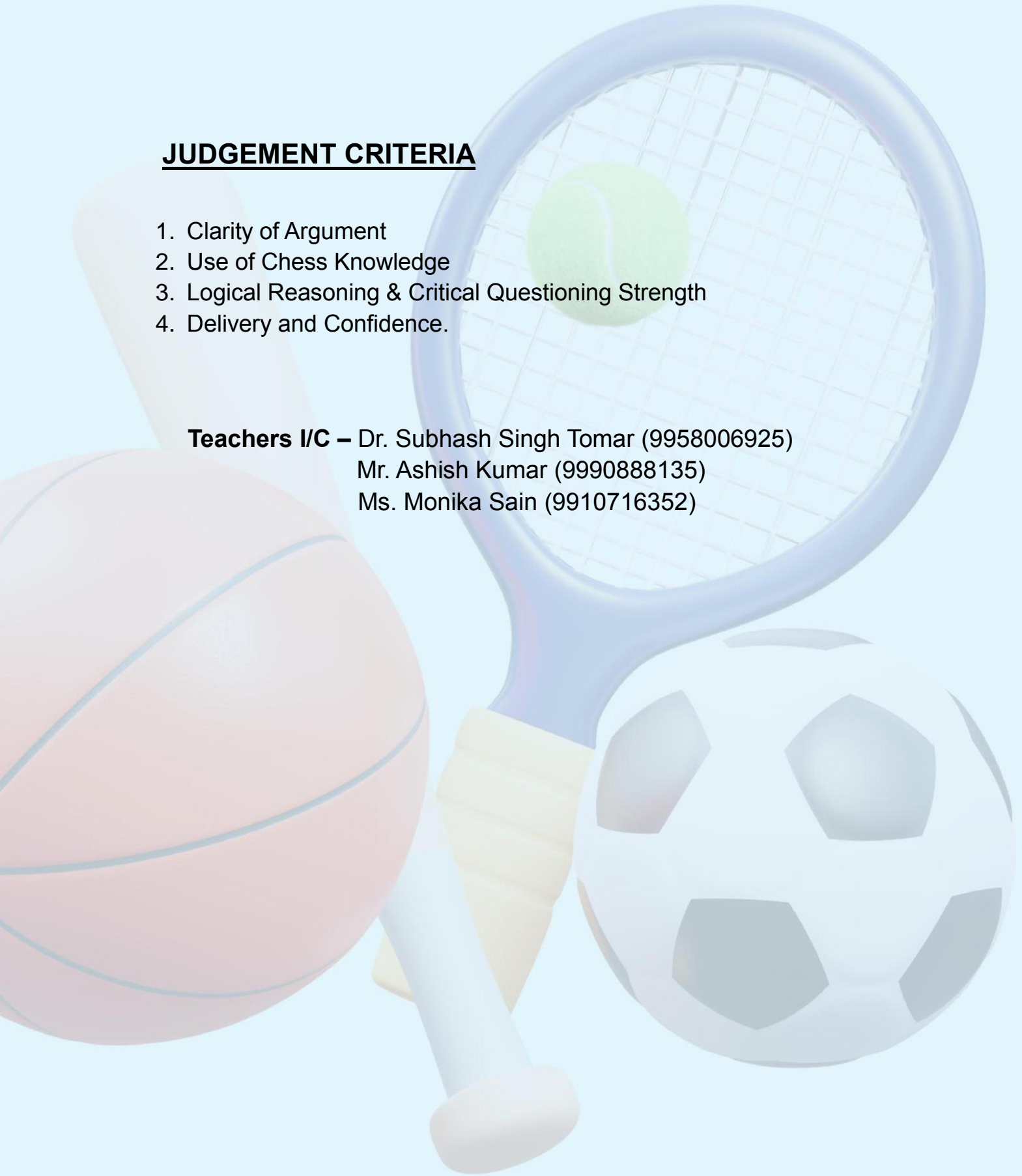
SAMPLE TOPICS

EVENT : **TABLE TENNIS TOURNAMENT**

CATEGORY : School Boys up to class VII

NUMBER OF PARTICIPANTS : A team of 4 students per school

GENERAL GUIDELINES

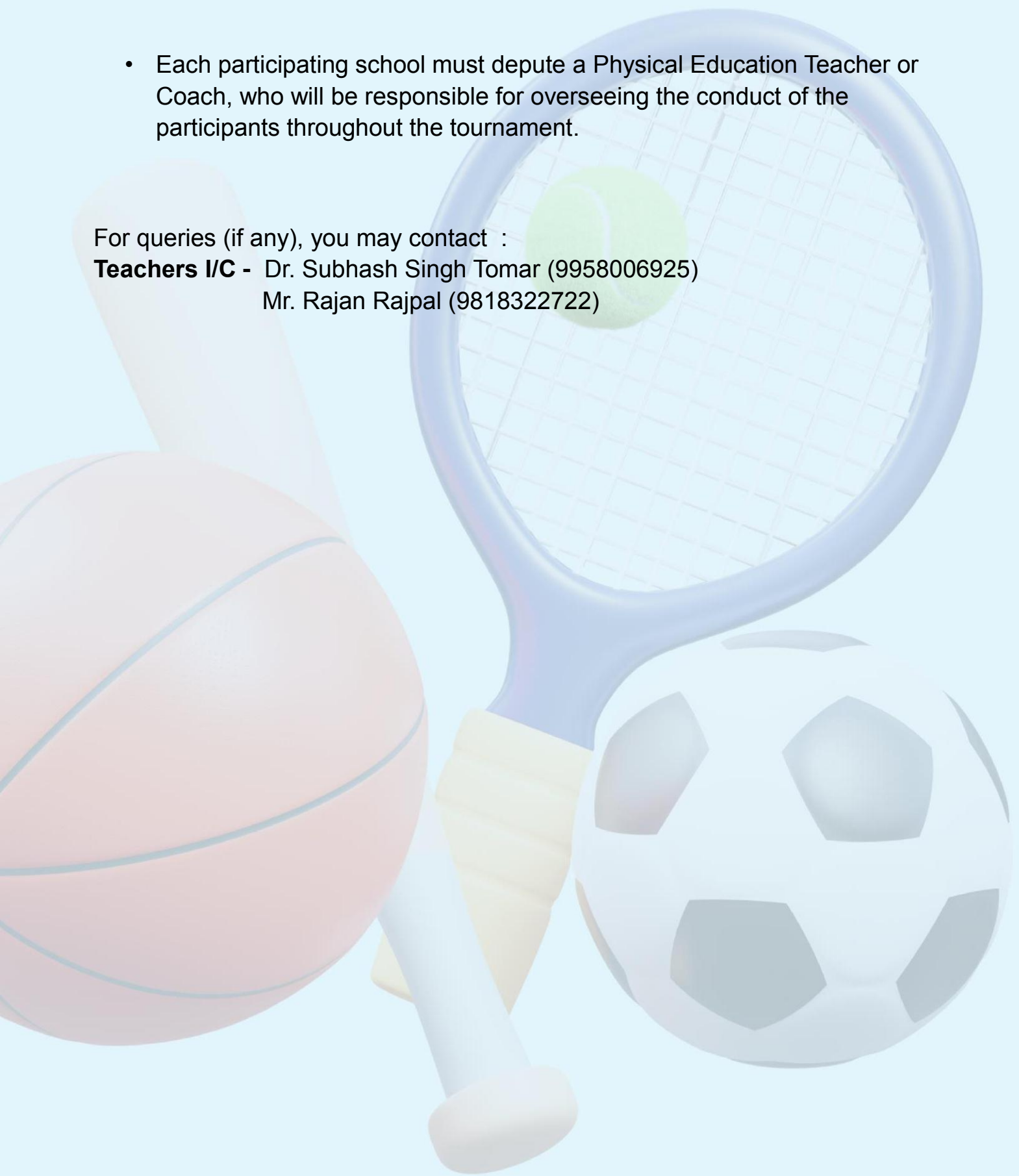
- All the matches will be played according to the rules of The Table Tennis Federation of India.
- All participants must bring their identity- cards for the current academic session, duly attested by the respective Principal.
- The date of birth and class of each participant must be certified by the Principal.
- All the participating players are required to wear the official school sports kit throughout the tournament.
- The teams' championship will be determined on knock out basis.
- Each championship round will consist of best of five matches comprising all singles.
- The order of play shall be :
 - A Vs. Y
 - B Vs. Z
 - Doubles
 - A, B Vs. YZ
- Each match will be played as 'Best of Five' games of 11 points.
- Teams must report to the venue 30 minutes prior to their scheduled match. If a team does not arrive at the venue within 15 minutes of the scheduled time, a walkover shall be awarded to the opposing team.
- Protests must be submitted in writing to the organizing school within 20 minutes of the conclusion of the match, accompanied by a protest fee of ₹1000/-
- Decision of the tournament committee will be final and binding on all teams.
- Trophies will be awarded to the winners, Runners up and 2nd Runners up. Team prizes will be distributed to all the members of winning and runners-up teams, along with merit certificates.

- Each participating school must depute a Physical Education Teacher or Coach, who will be responsible for overseeing the conduct of the participants throughout the tournament.

SPORTS CLUB

EVENT	:	FOOTBALL TOURNAMENT (Invitational Tournament)
CATEGORIES	:	School boys up to Class VII
NUMBER OF PARTICIPANTS	:	A team of 10 students per school
DURATION	:	20-5-20 minutes

GENERAL GUIDELINES

- No team shall be allowed to participate unless accompanied by a coach/teacher deputed by the school Principal
- Each team shall comprise a maximum of ten players, specifically seven boys and three girls, in addition to a manager or coach.
- Kindly note :
 - ✓ No offside rule in 7-a-side format
 - ✓ Throw-ins: Taken from the sidelines
 - ✓ Goal kicks: Taken anywhere inside the penalty area.
 - ✓ Corner kicks: Opponents must be 5 yards away.
 - ✓ Rolling substitutions are allowed (players can come on/off repeatedly).
- The duration of the match will be 20-5-20 minutes. In case of a draw, the match shall be decided by penalty shootouts at the end of the full time game.
- There is no entry fee for the teams.
- Only 8 teams will be permitted entry to the tournament based on a first come-first served basis.
- Each team is required to report 30 minutes before the scheduled match time.
- Players must carry their school identity cards valid for the current session.
