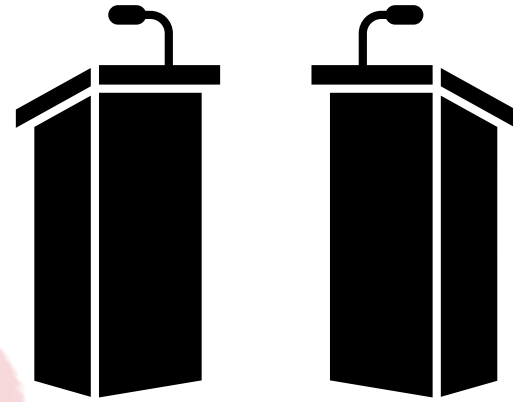
Movie show (Sitaare Zameen Par)
