
**Q.1** Read the story ‘**The Revenge of the Puppet**’

(Karadi Path). Underline the past tense verbs and write them in Scrapbook.


Create summary of the story using past tense verbs.



**Step 4:** Subtract (bigger – smaller)     $6432 - 2346 = 4086$


**2: Make a Shadow Puppet**
