Q1.WEIGHT ACTIVITY – “My Kitchen Weight Hunt”

Material: Kitchen items at home.

Task: Write the weight of the following items using the packet labels. In your notebooks.

Aata, Sugar, Dal, Biscuit packet, Oil bottle

Then do:

1. Add any two weights
2. Subtract any two weights
3. Convert grams ↔ kilograms
4. Make your own word problem using weights and solve it.



OR

FRACTIONS – “Winter Smoothie Recipe”

Task: Create a simple smoothie recipe using fractions. Example:

1/2 cup milk, 1/4 cup banana, 1/4 cup strawberries OR any other seasonal fruit of your choice.

On a A4 sheet do the following.

- ✓ Draw the ingredients you have used in recipe
- ✓ Write the fractions of quantities used
- ✓ Add the fractions to check total = 1 cup
- ✓ Change the recipe for 2 people → double the fractions



Q2. Assignment

1.A school garden is divided into 10 equal parts. Students plant flowers in 4 parts and vegetables in 3 parts.

Questions:

- a) What fraction of the garden has plants?
- b) What fraction is still empty?
- c) Which values do students learn by gardening together?

2. On Sports Day, the school planned a relay race.

To mark the track, the teacher used two ribbons:

Ribbon A = 4 m 25 cm

Ribbon B = 1 m 75 cm

The ribbons were tied together to make one long ribbon.

Questions:

- a) Find the total length of the ribbon.
- b) If the race track needs 6 m of ribbon, will the ribbon be enough?
- c) Find the total length of ribbon in centimeters?

Science

1. Types of Forces Around Me

What the child does: The child observes different types of forces used in daily life.

The child will: Identify any 6 activities showing force:

- * Pushing a door * Pulling a drawer
- * Kicking a ball * Stretching a rubber band
- * Lifting a bag * Braking a bicycle

Assignment :

1. Type of force (push/pull)
2. What change it causes (speed/shape/direction)
3. Draw or paste pictures.
4. Present on an A4/A3 sheet or chart paper.

“My Green Home” Poster

Make a creative poster on:

“How my family can save energy at home”

Write at least 6 ideas + draw them

Social Science

1. My Biosphere Health Card

Link: Biosphere + Pollution impact

What the child does: Creates a “health card” for plants/people/animals around them.

They list:

- Symptoms of pollution (watering eyes, coughing, dusty leaves, low sunlight)
- Why this happens in winter
- 3 things we can do to help

Question: Based on your Biosphere Health Card, explain how winter pollution affects living beings around you. Mention any two symptoms you observed and two actions you can take to reduce pollution.



OR

Realms Around Me – Local Survey

Link: Realms of Earth + Local environment

What the child does:

For 5 days, students will note one example of each realm around their home or park and then note how winter pollution affects each (dust on leaves, smoky smell, poor visibility etc.)

- Lithosphere: Soil, pathways
- Hydrosphere: Pond, tap water, water tank
- Atmosphere: Morning sky
- Biosphere: Plants, birds, pets

Makes a final chart with four columns.

Question: After observing the four realms around your home, which realm do you think is most affected by winter pollution? Give one reason for your choice and suggest one step to reduce its impact.

Sample Observation Chart (Four Columns)

Realm	Example Observed	Effect of Winter Pollution	One Way to Help
Lithosphere	Soil in park	Dust layer on soil	Avoid littering, plant grass
Hydrosphere	Tap water	Water smells due to pollution	Use water carefully
Atmosphere	Morning sky	Fog and smog, poor visibility	Use public transport
Biosphere	Plants near home	Dusty leaves- slow growth	Clean leaves, water plants
