Geometric Requirements: * Include at least three types of quadrilaterals (e.g., a rectangular dance floor, a trapezoid gift table).

2) Include at least two circles (e.g., a fountain or a rug) and label their radius and diameter.

3) Use a protractor to ensure your room corners are exactly 90° and include one "chill zone" with an obtuse angle.

4) Find the Perimeter and Area of your two largest structures.

The Goal: Analyze the trends and preferences of your family and friends during the break.

Task:

The Survey: Choose a festive topic (e.g., "Favorite Holiday Snack" or "Hours spent sleeping vs. playing"). Survey at least 15 people.

Data Representation:

Organize the raw data into a Tally Marks table.

Create a colorful Bar Graph to represent the findings.

Write a short "Executive Summary" (3 sentences) explaining what the Mode of your data is and one interesting observation.
