Hints: **cake, balloons, gifts, friends, music, games, happy, surprise, party, fun**

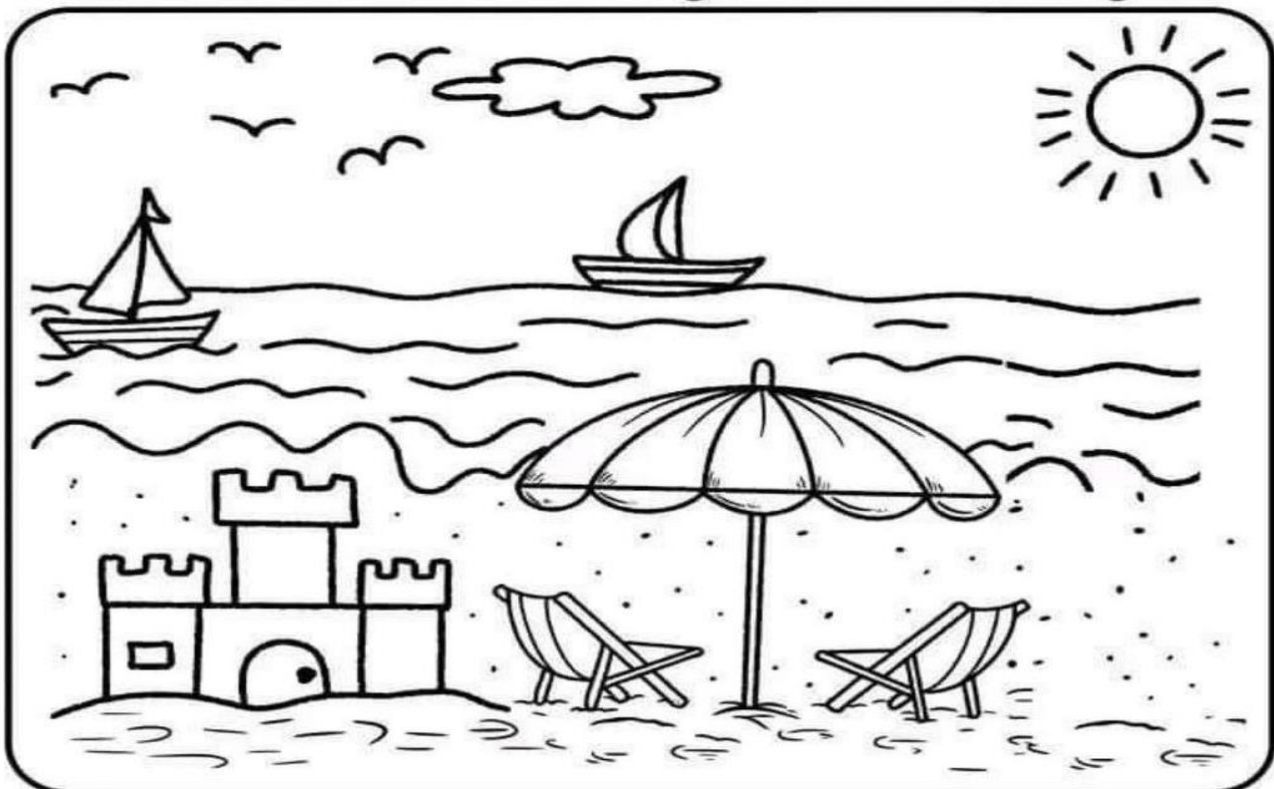
Activity 3: Draw and Label – My Favourite Object

Activity 4: 🐾 “My Favourite Animal Mask”

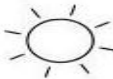

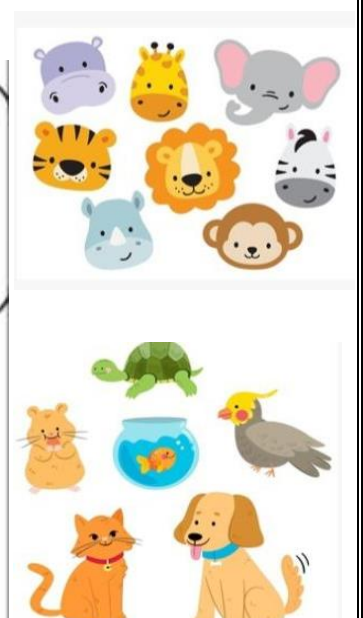
