5. The project report will be developed in this sequence:

1. **Front Page /Cover-** Cover page showing project title, student information, Name of the school and year
2. **Index-** List of contents
3. **Acknowledgement.**
4. **Introduction**
5. **Content** (10-12) pages.
6. **Conclusion** (summary and suggestions or findings, future scope of study)
7. **Bibliography.**
8. **Appendix** (if needed)
