The Pratap University, Jaipur was established by the Pratap University, Jaipur Act, 2011 passed by the Rajasthan Legislative Assembly.

As per Section 4 of the Act, the University is authorized to run courses as mentioned in Schedule II of the Act. This Schedule of the Act (as on date) is attached. It is expected that the university would run courses as mentioned in Schedule II of the Act as per provisions of section 4.

You are also aware that the university is expected to comply with the section 32 of the Act for the admission process for various courses being run by the university. As per the section 32 of the Act:-

"32. Admissions.- (1) Admission in the University shall be made strictly on the basis of merit.

(2) Merit for admission in the University may be determined either on the basis of marks or grade obtained in the qualifying examination and achievements in co-curricular and extra-curricular activities or on the basis of marks or grade obtained in the entrance test conducted at the State level either by an association of the universities conducting similar courses or by any agency of the State:

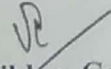
Provided that admission in professional and technical courses shall be made only through entrance test.

(3) Reservation in admission to the University for Scheduled Castes, scheduled tribes, backward classes, special backward classes, women and handicapped persons shall be provided as per the policy of the State Government."

It is also expected that university must comply with the above provisions of law for admission of students in various courses.

You are requested that a certificate stating that the university is running courses mentioned in schedule II as per section 4 of the Act and admissions are being given following section 32 of the Act, should be made available to the Department by 31st March, 2019.

It needs no re-iteration that compliance of the above provisions must be made compulsorily in the coming academic sessions 2019-2020 and subsequently as well.

Sir,

Please refer to your letter no. PU/2013-14/Letter/0006 dated 27.5.2013 vide which proposal has been sent to accord the approval of the State Government for starting of new disciplines in the Pratap University, Jaipur.

In this connection, in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 4 of the Pratap University, Jaipur Act, 2011, the approval of the State Government is hereby accorded for starting of following new disciplines from the academic session 2013-14 in the Pratap University, Jaipur:-

1. Pharmacy
2. Architecture
3. Tourism Hotel and Hospitality Management
4. Arts Culture Humanities and Social Sciences
5. Law
6. Education including Physical Education
7. Library and Information Science
8. Basic and Applied Science

This approval is subject to the following conditions:-

1. That the requisite infrastructure for the above new courses shall be developed as per norms of the concerned regulating bodies.
2. Prior approval of the relevant regulating bodies/competent authorities/departments shall be taken before starting of the new courses.
3. The standards of the syllabus of degrees and minimum eligibility criteria shall not be lower than prescribed by the concerning regulating bodies.
4. All other norms and conditions of the regulating bodies/competent authorities/departments relating to above new courses shall be fulfilled.
