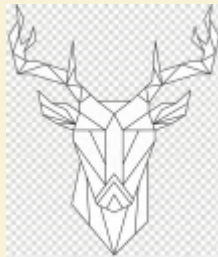

Activity 2

Inked-String Patterns

What to do :Take a sheet of paper. Fold it in half. Take some pieces of strings and dip them in a variety of coloured inks (or paints).

Spread the strings on one half side of the folded paper.

Now, press the two halves together on a flat surface and open it. the resulting figure is symmetrical and the line of fold (shown dotted) is the line of symmetry.

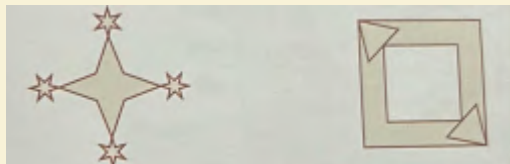
